



When a file or picture is added or changed in one place, it will automatically appear that way in the other as soon as you turn it on.





If you have Windows 7, you can right click when you're on the page and then select "translate with Bing." It's not a perfect translation but it helps a lot. If you scroll down the page to where it says "La collection Fourmaintraux-Frères" and click on it, the first page of items will appear, You need to click on each link to see the next page. I'm in the process of asking permission to use just the salt images on my website so they would all be in one group, but so far no luck. These are the works of Formaintraux Brothers. There are also 3 or 4 images of salts in the "La collection Fourmaintraux-Courquin" link. So even if we have unmarked pieces like my lion, I know it was made by Foumaintraux. It also comes as a double salt. I have the single. Mary's tall rabbit is there but not shown with any salts at all.
