Debi, I have two examples with decorations similar to your #475. The one on the right is impressed marked "Patent Mosaic". In her book, *A Pottery Panorama, Dudson Bicentenary 1800-2000*, the author, Audrey M. Dudson show a picture of the pattern, called Black Gordon on page 130. Quoting from the book: "Once again the ware was rarely marked DUDSON but it now appears, however that it was marked PATENT MOSAIC followed by a shape name and a pattern number. Extensive research has been carried out by others, not only in Britain, into the various rouletted patterns available to the industry. This has led to the conclusion that two of these patterns are unique to Dudson - namely Black Gordon and Linked Arrowheads"

Regarding your number 478. It is the same shape and similar color to the picture I posted, number 319 which I indicated was attributed to Dudson. Again, I will quote from the book, page 54, to justify my conclusion about the manufacturer: "Jasper Ware as produced at the Hope Street Dudson works was not marked with the factory name but it does frequently have a means of identification by the hand-incised decoration number on the base. It is not strictly a design or pattern number but gives instruction as to how this pot was to be decorated." The book continues to say that this number system was used throughout the 19th century. I tried to get a picture of the bottom of my salt but the number does not show up clearly, it is hand inscribed 1646, but only the first two digits are clear in the picture. I have several other

	<p>salts this same shape (can't locate them now), some with metal rings like yours and some without, mostly in blue dipped jasper ware with white sprigging in the Wedgwood style; that is, the figures are similar to Wedgwood but are not placed in the same manner. Each is marked with a similar 4 digit number. I have seen these unmarked (no factory mark) salts offered frequently, always in this same pan shape. Some are impressed with a "W" which people mistakenly assume stands for Wedgwood, but I understand that Wedgwood is almost always marked. The Adams salts are always marked and shaped differently. Please check the bottom of your salt and let me know if there is a hand inscribed number, probably 4 digits.</p>
