



Someone once told me there are extra small egg cups as well as larger than normal sized ones because people (especially the English) would eat all sorts of eggs. Partridge eggs are small and a couple egg cup shapes I have are way too small for a hen egg, but a smaller egg would fit. Janelle's salt might be a smaller egg cup at only 1-1/4" diameter, but there are salts with that shape so it's impossible to know for sure, unless the pattern could be identified and then what pieces were made in that pattern. Some toothpicks look like mini goblets too.





