Transferware

Transferware is putting a tissue thin "decal" on the piece which is covered with glaze then fired. Flow blue transerware was originally a mistake where the piece was fired too long or with too much heat where the blue color bled. It became popular. There are not very many flow blue salts. All flow blue is transferware, but not all transferware is flow blue. Besides other solid colors (brown, red, green, black, purple and yellow) of transferware, there is also multicolored and chintz transferware. Look for a line that does not match up in the pattern.
