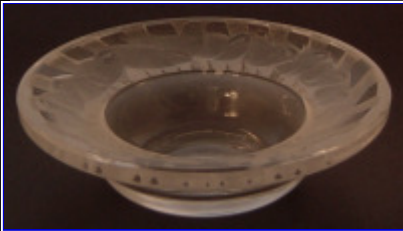

The other mark has three initials HFK, with the H & F joined at the back of the F, and a tiny form above that looks like a coffee pot, handle on the right, spout on the left. I assume this is the mark of the maker, but I have no way to identify that.
