Janelle: I think people confuse any mica flakes mixed in glass with spangle glass. All the Italian Murano swans have mica in clear glass. My understanding of spangle glass is at the bottom of page 8 here:

<http://opensalts.us/References/AuctionResu...ar-JeffreyEvans.pdf>

It appears to have a rough texture, not under a layer of clear glass. Wish I had one but I don't. Maybe someone does and can explain it better.

Regarding the definition you posted, it looks like more like the definition of spatter glass rather than spangle glass. Spangle glass is not necessarily multi-colored glass but spatter glass is.

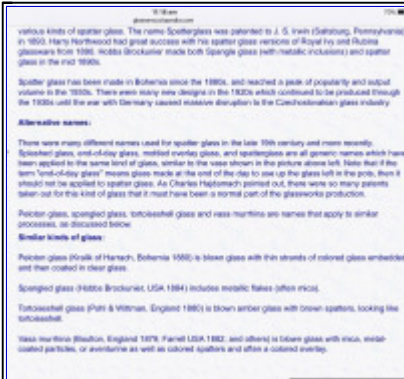

I had saved some information when I was researching it and thought when it had mica etc it was spangled and without it was spatter. The Murano type glass usually just defines it as inclusions. Maybe just different definitions in different countries. This is what I was going by.

It does appear to me to have some ridges around the gold areas. I shouldn't have called it rough, but it does look like you could feel some texture. The definition seems to say any glass with mica or metallic particles is spangled glass. I think the cobalt example is quite different from mica flakes encased in clear glass. But that's just my interpretation. I've only seen a couple examples of what I would call spangled glass, but a lot with mica flakes. I would not consider all the Murano glass with gold flecks as spangle glass.

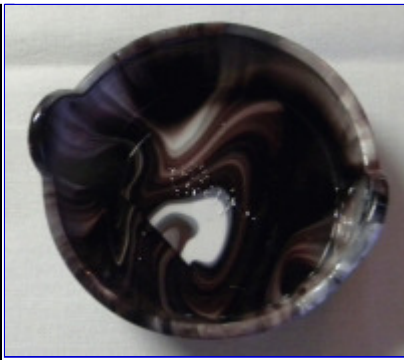

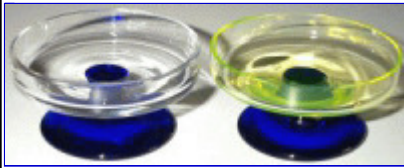
