



Thanks, Jytte. I used to belong to a very helpful on-line group of glass and pottery collectors. We categorized ourselves as "glassies" or "potties". I was a glassy.

But here are two pottery salts I've always liked. I think both are by Macintyre though only the on on the right is marked. English registry mark and the word Macintyre impressed, hard to read.

I got it from a most kind English seller. I told him it was missing a rim when I purchased it, and he checked with a friend who had one like it with a rim and an extra rim. So he included the loose rim in the package when he mailed it to me. The rim is some sort of base metal, or a silvered one that has lost all its silver. The one on the left looks like Macintyre to me, but the rim is marked EPNS for electro plated nickel silver. A very similar pair are pictured in the OSC at Plate 650, page 219.


