



Lynda: It was in 1921 that wares coming into the US had to be marked Japan instead of Nippon. But if you think that being marked Nippon makes it older than 1921, guess again. Do an internet search for Nippon marks and you'll see how many "old" marks are used on repros. While I think it's safe to assume most of your sets probably are original, it's not entirely a safe bet. Many pieces were made in other countries, like China, using the old Nippon marks and a label that was easily removed. AA Imports also used the marks and had labels
