Known colors: Opaque white, pastel shades of blue, pink and yellow with various hand painted decorations.

Note: Glass was made by Mount
Washington but decorated by Smith
Bros. Some have locations as
"Onset", MA for souvenir trade or
words such as "Easter". As far as it is
known only some of the "Prunus
Blossom" decorated ones have been
found with the Smith Bros. mark. A
few also bear a Libbey Glass mark.
True reason for this mark is not
known but said to be from the
1893 Chicago World's Fair.
Same as H&J 35-44 and
H&J 63-64 are master size.
