

# FOSTORIA and L.E. SMITH GRAPE LEAF NUT DISHES or OPEN SALTS

## Fostoria Clear Dish

2-5/8" Long – Back to Tip  
2-1/2 " Wide  
15/16" High

Pointed leaf tips with a serrated edge,  
three grape cluster-shaped feet that stay  
in a half inch round cluster.



## L. E. Smith Clear Salt

2-3/8 " Long – Back to Tip  
2-5/8" Wide  
15/16" High

Rounded leaf tips with less pronounce  
edge than Fostoria. Three grape cluster  
feet that graduate up the side and form  
an oval.



Fostoria introduced their number 2513  
GRAPE LEAF nut dish in 1935 and  
discontinued it in 1942. It was available  
in clear, burgundy, empire green and  
regal blue.



L.E. Smith is found in clear, white milk  
glass, **RARE** flashed marigold, blue and  
pink; also clear with cranberry feet.
