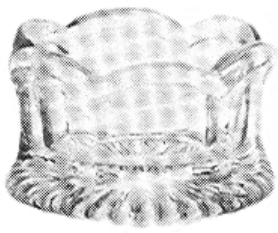
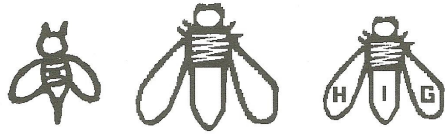

Two marks have been found on some L. G. Wright reproductions of Higbee patterns. At left, the thinner bee—or "Hornet"—was seen on pieces in the "Thistle" pattern (Higbee's Delta). The middle mark, almost identical to Higbee's original bee, has also been seen. But it is unclear whether the trademark itself was altered, or whether Botson imitated the Higbee trademark.
