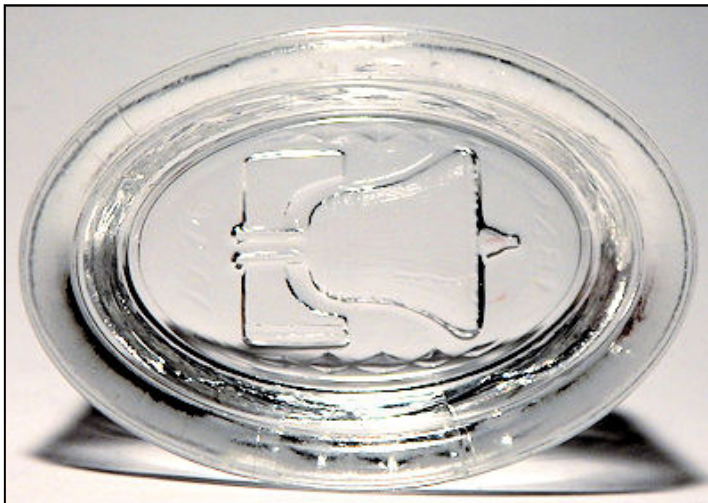

Note: Often referred to as the Centennial pattern. Gillinder made a Centennial pattern that bears no resemblance to this.

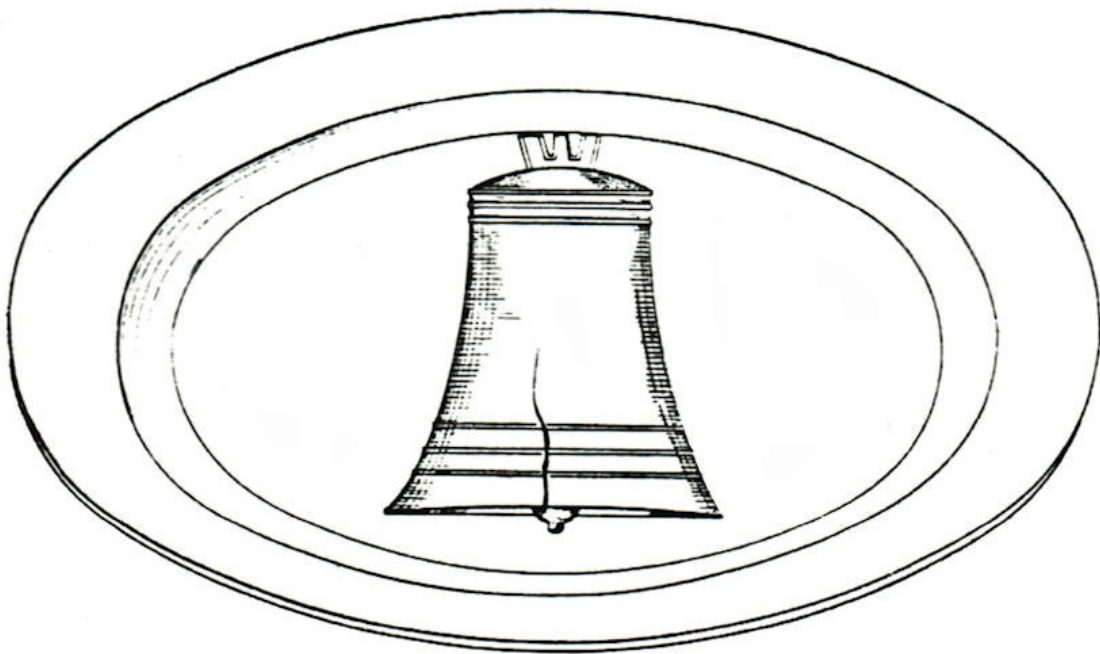

Possible patent for Liberty Bell Pattern

It is possible that the design of this pattern was patented by James C. Gill on September 28, 1875, Design Patent #8663. Gill may have sold the patent rights to Adams & Co. but we have had no success in confirming this. Gill was from Pittsburgh and we have not connected him with any glass firm. (Welker book)
